FAQ – Frequently Asked Questions

0. **Will this camp be postponed because of the Coronavirus?** As of right now we hope to do the camps in the dates scheduled, however if necessary, we will postpone the camp depending on what the circumstances are.

1. **Why are we doing this camp?** We are doing this camp mainly for all high school students (boys and girls) that cannot afford the expensive camps and want to be exposed to soccer college recruiters.

2. **How much does this college camp cost?** The cost is \$20 per player for this 1-day camp, the payment must be done online (www.houstonfutbol.com).

3. **How do I apply?** You must complete the online application (www.houstonfutbol.com) as soon as possible since only 120 players will be selected to attend this camp.

4. **When will the final list of players selected be announced?** The final list of players will be announced approximately one week before the camp. It will be published in the official website.

5. **What should I bring?** Please bring the following: white socks, black shorts, all-white jersey, grass soccer shoes, hard surface running shoes, own water, own soccer ball and snacks. There will be a concession stand so bring some money and Dairy Queens is also within walking distance.

6. **What is the schedule of events like?** The official schedule of events is posted on the website.

7. **What college coaches will be in attendance?** The final list of college coaches will be announced approximately 3 days before the camp.

8. **Will pro team scouts be in attendance?** Yes, they be there, they are coming from Mexico and the USA to look for talent. The final list of coaches will be listed approximately 3 days before the camp.

10. **Who is eligible for this camp?** All current High School students (10th, 11th, and 12th graders) from the 2019-2020 school year are eligible to participate, however only 120 students will be invited. Athletes that are not in high school will be eligible in a case by case basis.
